

Conference Directions

From I-5 north or southbound, take the SR 14 exit east towards Camas. Take Exit 1 south. Turn right (south) under the railroad overpass. At the signal, turn left (east) onto Columbia Way. Go about 1.6 miles to the traffic island.

From I-205 north or southbound, take the SR-14 exit, head west towards Vancouver. Travel approximately 4 miles to Columbia House Boulevard, Exit 1. Travel west to the freeway underpass intersection. Turn south to Columbia Shores (follow the signs) and go under the railroad overpass. At the signal, turn left (east) onto Columbia Way. Go approximately 1.5 miles to the traffic island.

At Traffic Island - Follow the road to the left and turn right into the first driveway. The WREC is on the right, and overflow parking is on the left at the Engineering Building.
