

Drug Take Back Program

March 13, 2010, in a unified statewide effort to keep drugs out of the wrong hands and out of our water, a one-day public event will take place. The sponsors of the event are the Oregon Medical Association Alliance, a grassroots non-profit organization of physician spouses and Oregon Partnership, the premier resource for drug prevention services in Oregon.

In each community we are partnering with local law enforcement and drug prevention coalitions. An important component to our event is education. We will be promoting the “Lock Your Meds” campaign and “Smart Disposal”. We are continuing to look for partners to help reinforce the message that drugs in the wrong hands and the environment can be dangerous.
